8. Join the union that does what the company says, and never join one that talks about rights, dignity, or pay raises.
9. Believe that the police look out for you, that the military protects you (and the country as well), and that the Church watches over the poor.
10. Believe that you only have the right to have what you can buy, even if you need it to live, like food and medicine.
11. Accept without question that others think for you, what is best for you.
12. You have to adapt; only those who adapt survive.
